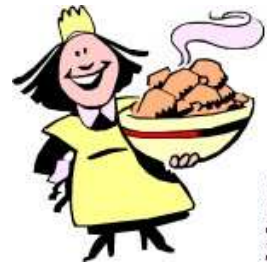

What is the Baking Brigade?

The Baking Brigade is an on-call list of volunteers who can help provide Avalon Housing with a variety of baked goods and other treats for our events, property open houses and tenant gatherings.

How does it work?

We'll call or email the Brigade list when we have a baking need, and if there are any specific details for the event. We should always be able to give you a couple of weeks notice, and will coordinate on what you're baking and getting it to the event. We anticipate having needs about once per month.

What am I committing to?

Your only commitment is to be on our Baking Brigade contact list – you don't *have* to bake for every event, although you are welcome to do as much as you'd like! Once you have signed up for a specific event, we do ask that you give as much notice as possible if you will not be able to bake as planned. Ideally, members of the Brigade will be able to deliver their goodies to the event or to our main office on Jones Drive, but pick-up arrangements can be made in advance.

What about ingredient and other costs?

We would reimburse you for the costs of ingredients and any mileage costs incurred from shopping for and delivering the goodies. We do request that you provide receipts.

As a non-profit 501(c)3 organization, Avalon Housing would of course welcome a donation of the baked goods and ingredient costs if you choose to do so. We would be happy to provide a donation receipt for your personal tax purposes (where applicable under the law).

Can I bake anything I want? Do I have to share my recipes?

We do not specify what you should bake, although please keep in mind that a wide range of folks will be enjoying your hard work! It's better to stick to classic recipes and well-known ingredients.

We do not require you to share your recipes with us, although we do ask that you let us know about any ingredients that are potential allergens so we can let our guests know (milk, eggs, wheat, peanuts and other tree nuts, such as almonds, walnuts etc).
